NetLibrary

NetLibrary provides access to the library's eContent collection. eContent is the digital version of books and audiobooks which you can read or listen to on your computer or mp3 player (iPods do not currently work with NetLibrary).

Access: NC LIVE password (call 560-0110 or email librarywebmaster@durhamcountync.gov for current password)

Search Options:

- You can search all ebooks and eaudiobooks by Title, Author, Keyword, or Full Text in the search bar. If you want to search only through audiobooks or ebooks, click on eAudiobooks or eBooks on the right side of the screen and then type your search in the search box.
- Click on Search.
- Click on Try Advanced Search if you want to search by Publisher, Language, Publication Date, Subject, or ISBN.
- You can also use Advanced Search to search by more than one option at the same time or to sort your results.
- Click on Search.

Reading an eBook:

- To view an eBook, click on View this eBook from the eBook Search Results list.
- Once you are in the eBook you may print out a few pages but not an entire eBook, as this could violate copyright law in many cases.
- You can move through the eBook one page at a time by clicking on the Previous or Next icons on the top right corner of the screen. You can also type in a specific page number where it says Page and click Go.
- Clicking on a chapter title or number in the table of contents on the left side of the screen will take you to the beginning of that chapter.
- If you go to the index of a book, you will be able to click on the page numbers to go directly to those pages.
- To make an eBook easier to read, drag the line with the small red arrows on either side to the left. This will expand the text part of the screen and decrease the Table of Contents Bar. Drag the line back to the right to get full access to all the tools in the Table of Contents Bar again.
- Right click on an eBook for quick access to common options.
- Please close the eBook when you are done by right clicking and selecting close eBook, so someone else may use it in our library system.

Downloading eAudiobooks:

- Click on Download this eAudiobook from the list of titles.
- You can choose between a CD quality download, radio quality download, or just listen to the book from inside NetLibrary. If you download, you will have the eaudiobook for 21 days, after which the file will stop working. You can check out up to ten eaudiobooks at one time. There is no way to return eaudiobooks early.

Using Tools:

Dictionary Button:

Click on **Dictionary** to access a dictionary, thesaurus or to translate words from English to Spanish or Spanish to English.

Notes: Click **Notes** to take notes that will be attached to your account. You must be logged in to use this feature.

Search: Click **Search** to search for topics or phrases within the eBook or to search for a new eBook.

eBook Details: Click **eContent Details** for a brief description of the subjects discussed in the book and publication information.

Knowledge Tools: Click on **Knowledge Tools** to access an encyclopedia, a search engine, or an atlas.

Things to Remember:

- Cookies must be enabled on your browser for netLibrary to work properly.
- DCL does not have access to all eBooks in netLibrary.
- You can change your email address for your account but you cannot change your user name.
